7. Food Van

8. Resurfacing of the Car Park and the Footpath updates

Both orders have now been placed and we are awaiting a start date from Relay.

9. High Fencing along the Car Park

The first contractor who came along and took measurements failed to provide a quotation. Danbury Fencing have now been asked and am waiting for them to arrange a time to come along to assess.
